Describe present and historic physical appearance.

The Gallagher House is rectangular one and one-half story woodframe house, constructed of hand-sawn timber with small, handsplit cedar shingles as the cladding. The house has broken gable side roofline which extends to form front porch which has square shingle-clad pillars and a low railing. The house has center front gable dormer with gable-end fascia boards. Decorative knee braces and small, round knobs are at the apex of all gables. In the house are a variety of windows including four over four double hung wood sash, single pane fixed and a fixed window with six square panes.

The Gallagher (Hukee) House is significant as a typical house of the period owned by Con Gallagher who worked in woods as well as having his own small farm. Many of the wood workers in Thurston County lived and worked in similar circumstances. In the rapidly growing Lacey area. Few of these houses remain. Because the house has been moved (it would otherwise have been razed), the house meets criterion #g. in that it is a building or structure removed from its original location but which significant primarily for architectural value.

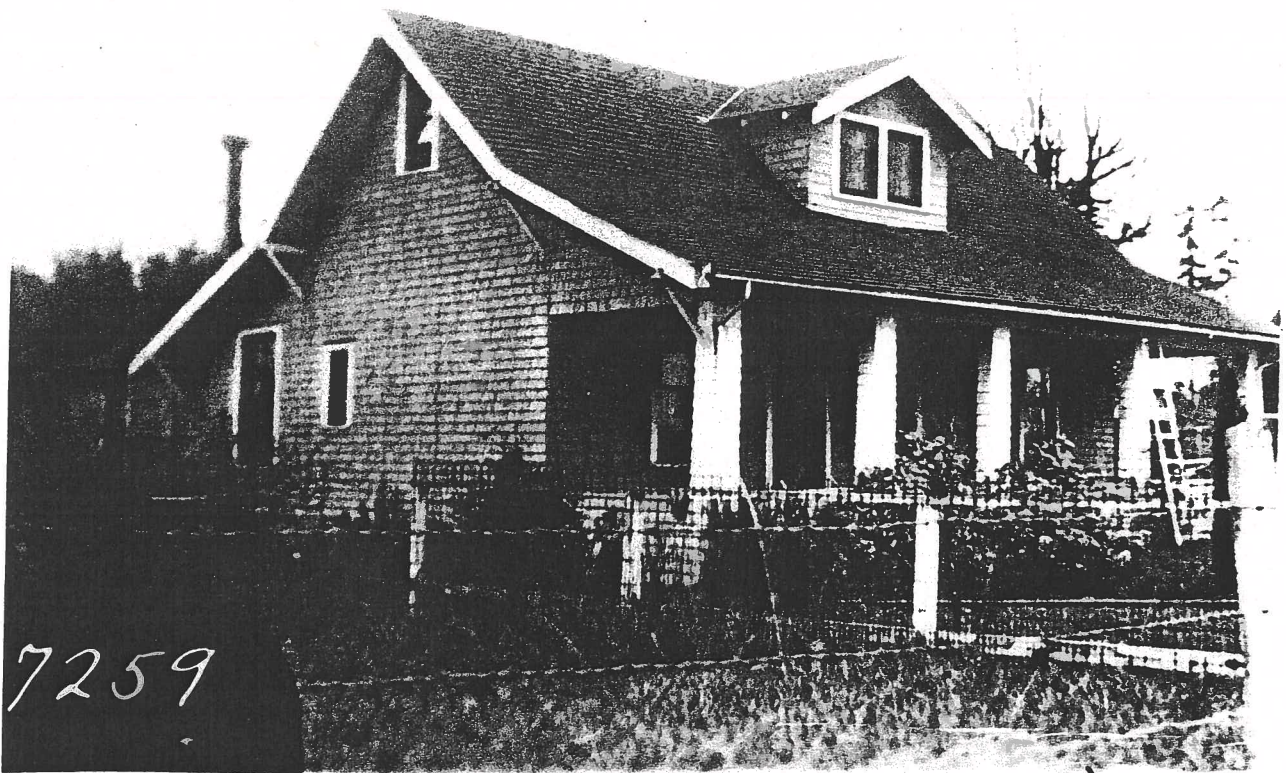

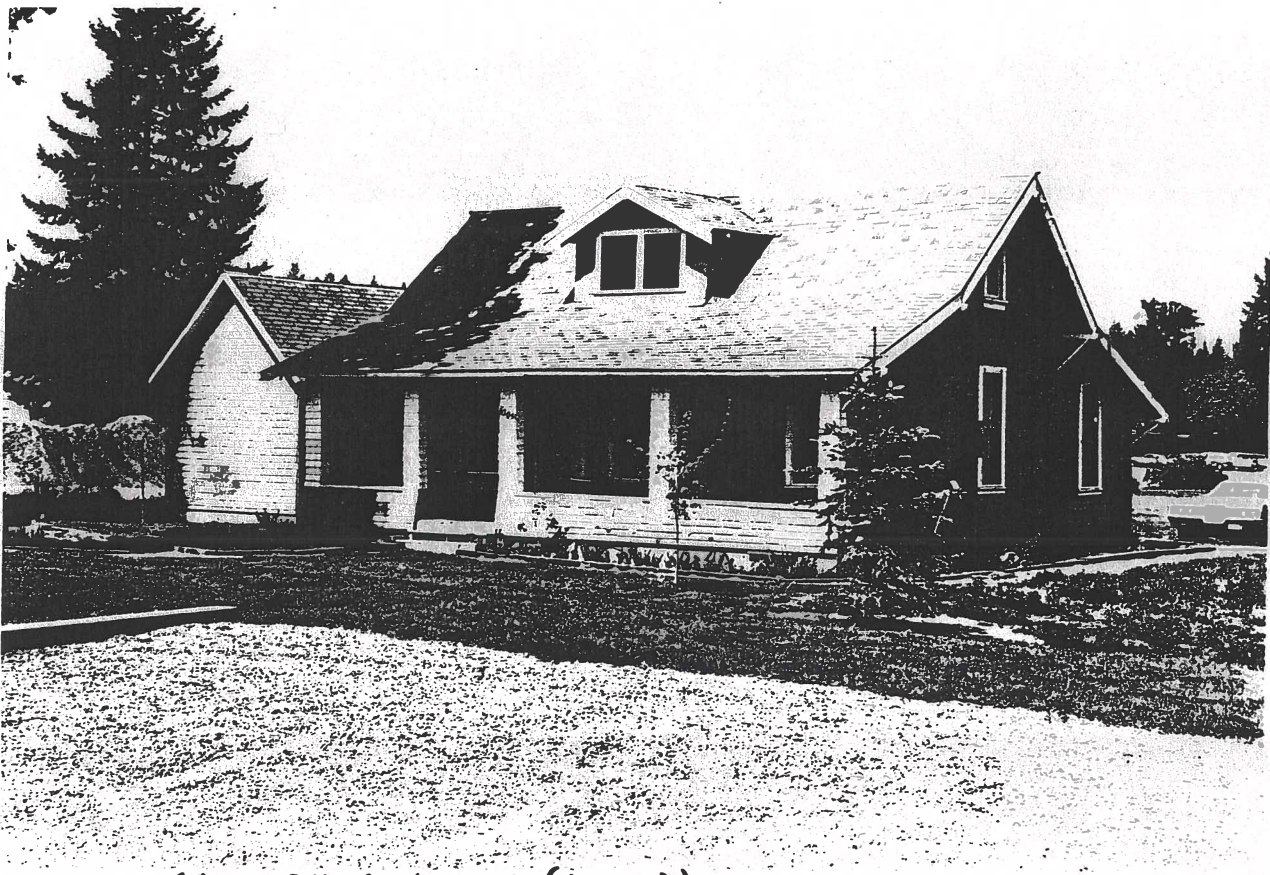
